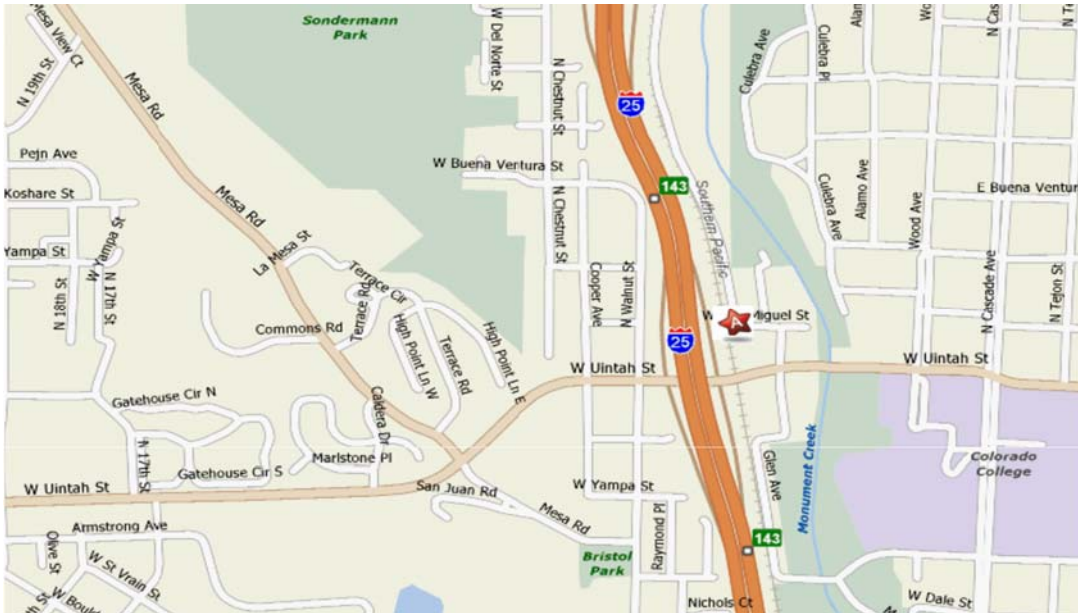


Possible closure of Captain Jacks trail head.

City council is looking at their options for the closure of 1.2 miles of trail known as Captain Jacks. If this happens the only way to access the Jones Park trail (Pike National Forest) will be at the top of High Drive. High Drive is seasonal, meaning that it is closed to motorized traffic for several months of the year.
